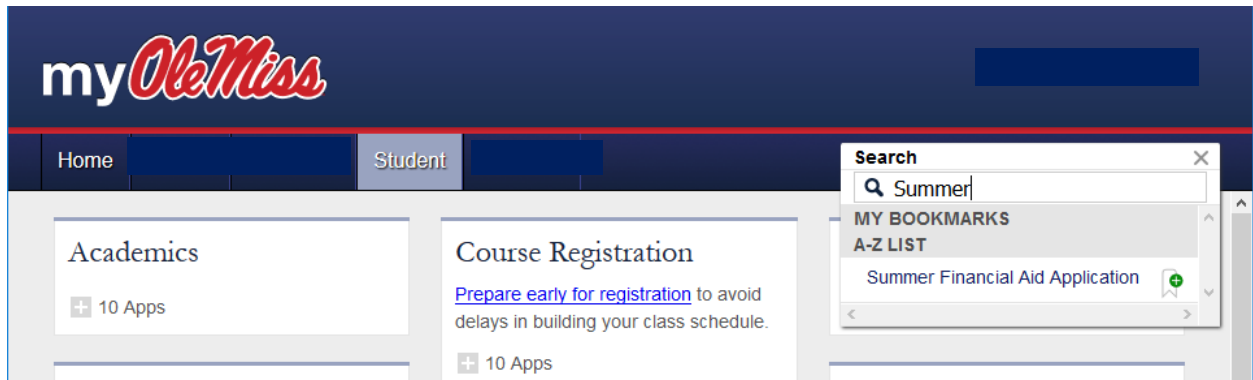


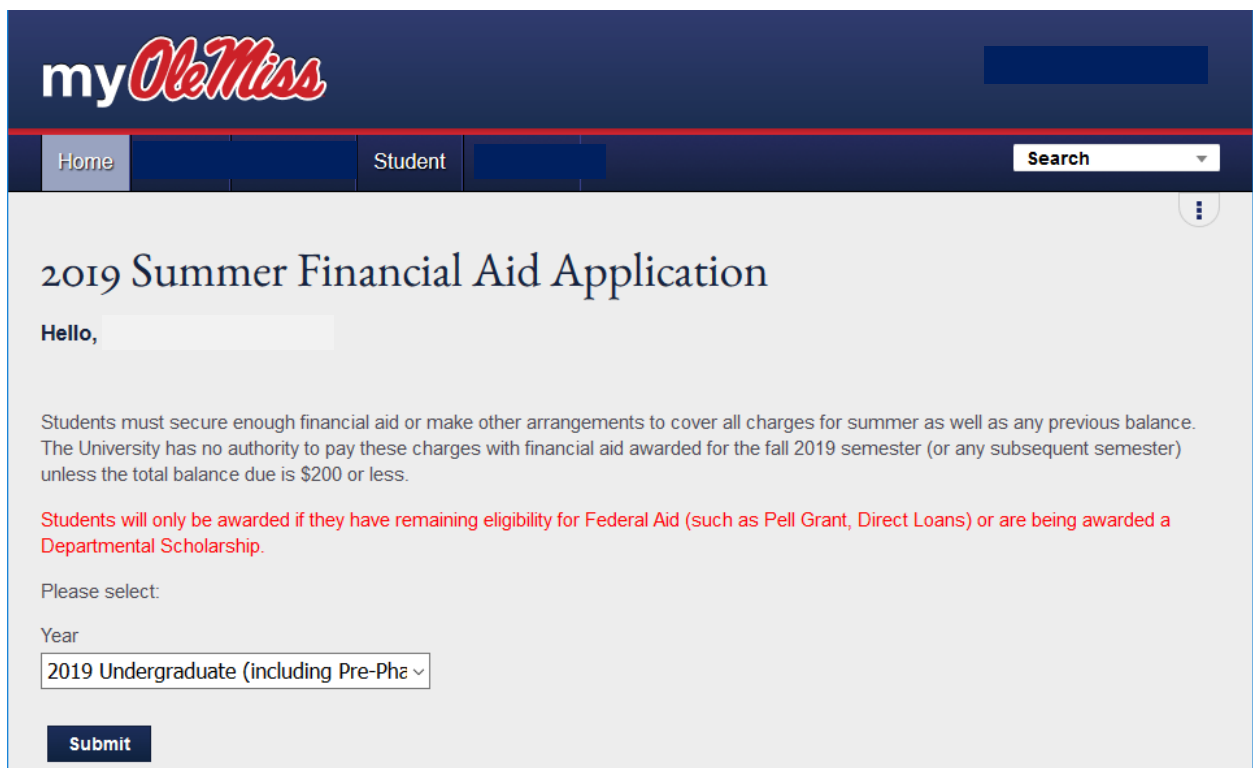
How to Complete the Summer Financial Aid Application

FOR DUAL CREDIT, SUMMER COLLEGE, and JUMPSTART STUDENTS

STEP 1: Log into my.olemiss.edu, search “Summer Financial Aid,” and select “Summer Financial Aid Application”



STEP 2: Start the application by selecting the year “2023 Undergraduate” and click “Submit.”



STEP 3: Verify that your information is correct on the next page and click “Next.”

STEP 4: The next page includes information about federal student financial aid. This does not apply to Summer College Program students. Check the box and the bottom of page and click “Next.”

2019 Summer Financial Aid Application

Students may apply for financial aid to attend summer school by following these instructions. There will be very limited funds available for Summer 2019.

Financial Aid Summer Checklist:

- You have completed the 2018-2019 FAFSA if applying for federal aid such as Pell Grant, Work-Study, and loans (including Federal Direct and PLUS loans—but also need-based institutional aid such as McKinstry loans). The deadline to submit a FAFSA is June 30, 2019.
- You must be enrolled prior to completing this application. (In general, you must have a minimum of 6 summer hours to receive federal aid.)
- You have checked your Financial Aid status to ensure that you are not on Financial Aid Suspension, in Verification, or have any other problems. If you have any issues that must be resolved, please call our Helpline at 800-891-4596 for assistance.

- The deadline to apply for **Summer Financial Aid** is July 31, 2019.
- Dependent students should plan to use a Direct Parent PLUS Loan or a Private Educational Loan. Independent students should plan to use a Private Educational Loan.
- If transferring to Ole Miss in Summer 2019, make certain you have added our school code (002440) to your 2018-2019 FAFSA online or by calling the federal processor at 800-433-3243. Also be sure to have your previous school(s) cancel any pending financial aid in order to avoid awarding delay at The University of Mississippi.
- If participating in Study Abroad or other off-campus programs, please review the financial aid information for **Study Abroad and Consortium Study**.
- If you change your summer schedule (number of classes or session in which you will enroll), you must revise your application. Only **two** revision of the application will be accepted online. If more than one revision is required, you must complete a paper application by visiting the Office of Financial Aid.
- If you are on Academic Suspension, you may want to consider the Contractual Readmission option instead of enrolling in summer. Click [here](#) for details.
- If you will be a graduate student for the first time this year during the summer term, be sure to update your FAFSA to reflect your academic level.
- Students may only receive federal financial aid for courses that are applicable to their degree. Therefore, courses used only to raise a student's grade point average or ones that are being repeated multiple times may not be considered for federal aid eligibility purposes.
- Most summer aid awards are contingent upon meeting satisfactory academic progress at the end of the spring term.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SUMMER – If you receive Title IV Federal Aid (Pell Grant, SEOG, Direct Loans, PLUS Loans, or TEACH Grants), please be aware that before funds can be released to you, YOU MUST BE ENROLLED in all credit hours for all summer terms that you have reported on your summer application. Therefore, your summer plans need to be made as soon as possible – and must match this application.

- No federal funds will be disbursed until an instructor has documented your attendance in at least one class. See <http://finaid.olemiss.edu/attendance-verification/>.
- If you do not begin attendance in all intended hours for all sessions, the Office of Financial Aid may be required to reduce/cancel funds and/or perform a Return of Title IV Funds calculation (typically necessitating paybacks) based on the total number of days you had been expected to complete.
- If you withdraw from a summer term, a Return of Title IV withdrawal calculation will be performed (typically resulting in a balance on your Bursar account) unless you provide our office with written notice of intent to enroll in an upcoming summer term.

Please note that revising your summer application will delay awarding and disbursements. Additionally, you may be required to return funds disbursed as a result of a previously submitted inaccurate application.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING APPLYING FOR FEDERAL DIRECT LOANS (SUBSIDIZED, UNSUBSIDIZED, PARENT PLUS, or GRADUATE PLUS) IN THE SUMMER SESSIONS

If you decide to borrow a Federal Direct Loan, it must be awarded to you while you are still enrolled in the appropriate summer mini term(s) (May Intersession, First Summer, Full Summer, Second Summer, or August Intersession). For example, if you enroll in only May Intersession and First Summer, and you attend class from May 14th to May 26th and again from May 29th to June 26th, we would only be able to process your loan request if it is submitted prior to June 26th. Our office needs 2-3 business days for processing, partly due to the U.S. Department of Education's approval process, so don't wait until the last day of finals to submit your request. If your parent is applying for a Parent PLUS Loan (for dependent students) or you are applying for a Graduate PLUS Loan (for graduate students), we urge you to submit the application through <https://studentloans.gov> at least a week prior to the end of the last mini session in which you plan to be enrolled.

If your request or application for a Federal Direct Loan is submitted less than 3 business days prior to the end of the appropriate mini term, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to process your request in time. Please contact the Office of Financial aid now with any questions so that you may plan ahead.
